

## 2018 LEAF PICKUP PROGRAM

The Public Works Department will once again be picking up leaves from curbsides this fall. Citizens may rake leaves into piles at the curb. **No sticks, grass clippings or other debris should be included – leaves only!** Do not bag your leaves. Any cars parked on the street should be moved, so that our crews can remove leaves safely and effectively.

**\* LEAF PILES BLOCKED BY VEHICLES WILL NOT BE PICKED UP \***

The program will begin October 22, 2018 with zone pick-ups as follows:

<b>Zones</b>	<b>Round 1</b>	<b>Round 2</b>
Zone 1:	October 22 - 23	November 14 - 15
Zone 2:	October 24 - 25	November 16 - 19
Zone 3:	October 26 & 29	November 20 - 21
Zone 4:	October 30 - 31	November 26 - 27
Zone 5:	November 1, 2, 5	November 28 - 30
Zone 6:	November 6 - 8	December 3 - 4
Zone 7:	November 9 & 12	December 5 - 6
Zone 8:	November 13	December 7

**NOTE:** Leaves will be picked up some time during the two-day or three-day window provided on the schedule for your zone. **Dates are estimates only and may be delayed due to weather and/or volume of leaves.** To ensure that your leaves are collected, we suggest that you have your leaves out on the curb prior to the **First** day of your zone's scheduled pick-up dates.

Citizens may obtain schedules and zone maps at the Public Works Building at 2400 Olive Road; at the Government Center located at 3035 Olive Road (2<sup>nd</sup> floor); at the Library at 651 E. Main Street or on-line @ [www.trotwood.org](http://www.trotwood.org).

**Public Work crews will attempt to make a final leaf run throughout the entire City, December 10<sup>th</sup> – 21<sup>st</sup>.**

At any time during the fall season, Rumpke will provide disposal of bagged leaves on your normal trash pick-up day (limit of 10 bags, per trash pick-up date); residents may call 461-0004 for more information.
