CITY OF TROTWOOD, OHIO DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2020, Governor Mike DeWine declared a state of emergency for the entire State of Ohio to protect the well-being of the citizens of Ohio from the dangerous effects of COVID-19 and to assist in protecting the lives, safety and health of the citizens of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Ohio Department of Health, Dr. Amy Acton, issued a Director's Order on March 12, 2020, which limited the size of public gatherings to less than one hundred (100) people; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Amy Acton, the Director of the Ohio Department of Public Health, issued a supplemental Director's Order on March 22, 2020, which directed persons to stay at home with certain exceptions; and

WHEREAS, COVID-19 endangers the lives of the citizens of Trotwood, Ohio, creating an emergency to life and public safety and disrupting commerce;


NOW, THEREFORE, it is declared that a state of emergency exists in the City of Trotwood, Ohio (the "City"), and the City hereby invokes those portions of the Ohio Revised Code which are applicable to the conditions that have caused the issuance of this proclamation on the Director's Orders, to be in full force and effect in the City of Trotwood for the exercise of all necessary emergency authority for protection of the lives and property of the citizens of the City of Trotwood.

Reference is hereby made to all appropriate laws, statutes, ordinances and resolutions, and particularly to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 5502.


All public offices and employees of the City of Trotwood are hereby directed to exercise the utmost diligence in the discharge of those essential duties required of them for the duration of the emergency and in the execution of emergency laws, regulations and directives, both state and local.

All citizens are called upon and directed to comply with necessary emergency measures to cooperate with public officials and disaster service forces in the execution of emergency operation plans, and to obey and comply with the lawful directions of properly identified officers.
