

RESOLUTION NO. R22-19

**A RESOLUTION BY THE TROTWOOD CITY COUNCIL
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT THE 2022
DISTRICT INCENTIVE GRANT: RECYCLE RIGHT CAMPAIGN
AWARD FROM THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY SOLID WASTE
DISTRICT.**

WHEREAS, the City of Trotwood, Ohio, has been awarded a grant from the Montgomery County Solid Waste District in the amount of \$136,692 for the purpose of replacing the deteriorating rubber surfacing and woodchips under the playgrounds at Broadway Parka and John Wolfe Park with recycled, non-toxic rubber surfacing; and

WHEREAS, the City is required to contribute funding in an amount equal to 30% of the total grant award amount of \$136,692, which represents a contribution of no less than \$41,007.60 from the City. The Montgomery County Solid Waste District's expected match request contribution is \$95,684.40; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager recommends that the Trotwood City Council authorize the City Manager to accept the grant funds from the Montgomery County Solid Waste District and to submit any Letters of Acceptance or other documents required by the Montgomery County Solid Waste District in furtherance of the receipt of the grant funds.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF TROTWOOD, STATE OF OHIO:**

SECTION I: The Trotwood City Council authorizes the City Manager to accept the grant awarded by the Montgomery County Solid Waste District, which total grant award amount is \$136,692, to replace the deteriorating rubber surfacing and woodchips under the playgrounds at Broadway Parka and John Wolfe Park with recycled, non-toxic rubber surfacing.

SECTION II: The City of Trotwood is required to contribute funding in an amount equal to 30% of the total grant award amount, which requires a contribution of no less than \$41,007.60 from the City.

SECTION III. Funds have been appropriated in the amount of \$41,007.60 for the City's share of the total project cost
