

RESOLUTION NO. R22-21

**A RESOLUTION BY THE TROTWOOD CITY COUNCIL
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT FEDERAL
FUNDS THROUGH THE CORONAVIRUS RESPONSE AND
RELIEF SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT AND THE
SURFACE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM FROM THE MIAMI
VALLEY REGIONAL PLANNING COMMISSION FOR
RESURFACING PROJECTS.**

WHEREAS, the City of Trotwood applied for federal funds from the Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission (“MVRPC”) for the purpose of resurfacing Salem Bend Drive, from Olive Road to Westbrook Road; and Free Pike, from the Trotwood eastern corporation limit to Wolf Creek Pike; and

WHEREAS, MVRPC has awarded Coronavirus Response And Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (“CRRSAA”) funds to resurface Salem Bend Drive from Olive Road to Westbrook Road, for a total project cost of \$183,557, with the City of Trotwood funding the preliminary engineering phase at a cost not to exceed \$18,360, and 100% of the construction engineering phase and the construction phase to be funded with CRRSAA funds, in an amount not to exceed \$165,197; and

WHEREAS, MVRPC has awarded Surface Transportation Program (“STP”) funds to resurface Free Pike from the Trotwood eastern corporation limit to Wolf Creek Pike, for a total project cost of \$882,458, with the City of Trotwood funding the preliminary engineering phase at a cost not to exceed \$74,785, and 20%, or \$161,535, of the construction engineering phase and the construction phase, and STP funds will be used to fund 80%, or \$646,138, of the construction engineering phase and the construction phase; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager recommends that the Trotwood City Council authorize the City Manager to accept the CRRSAA and STP federal funds from the MVRPC for the purpose of resurfacing Salem Bend Drive, from Olive Road to Westbrook Road; and Free Pike, from the Trotwood eastern corporation limit to Wolf Creek Pike, and to submit any documents required by the MVRPC in furtherance of the receipt of the federal funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROTWOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION I:

The Trotwood City Council authorizes the City Manager to accept from the Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission, CRRSAA federal funds in the amount of \$165,197 for the purpose of resurfacing Salem Bend Drive, from Olive Road to Westbrook Road; and STP federal funds in the amount of \$646,138 for the purpose of resurfacing Free Pike, from the Trotwood eastern corporation limit to Wolf Creek Pike.

SECTION II:

The City of Trotwood is required to contribute funding for the preliminary engineering phase of resurfacing Salem Bend Drive as described in Section I, in the amount of \$18,360, and CRRSAA federal funds from the MVRPC will be used to fund 100%, or \$165,197, of the construction engineering and construction phases, for a total project cost of \$183,557.

SECTION III:

The City of Trotwood is required to contribute funding for the preliminary engineering phase of resurfacing Free Pike as described in Section I, in the amount of \$74,785, and 20%, or \$161,535, of the construction engineering phase and the construction phase, and STP federal funds from the MVRPC will be used to fund 80%, or \$646,138, of the construction engineering and construction phases, for a total project cost of \$882,458.

SECTION IV:

Funds have been appropriated in the amount of \$254,680 for the City's share of the total cost for both projects.

SECTION V:

This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the date of its passage.
