

RESOLUTION NO. R22-25

A RESOLUTION BY THE TROTWOOD CITY COUNCIL ACCEPTING THE BID FROM AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH ROSSMAN ENTERPRISES, INC., DBA MAGNEGRIP, FOR THE PURCHASE OF VEHICLE EXHAUST REMOVAL SYSTEMS FOR THE CITY OF TROTWOOD FIRE STATIONS FOR THE TOTAL SUM OF \$152,781.00, TO BE PAID FOR WITH GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$138,891.82 FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT, AND THE REQUIRED MATCH OF 10%, OR \$13,889.18, FROM THE CITY OF TROTWOOD.

WHEREAS, the City of Trotwood was awarded a FEMA grant to purchase vehicle exhaust removal systems for the City of Trotwood Fire Stations; and

WHEREAS, the City of Trotwood advertised for bids and the bid received from MagneGrip is the lowest and best bid for the vehicle exhaust removal systems for the City of Trotwood Fire Stations; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager and the Fire Chief recommend that City Council authorize the City Manager to enter into an Agreement with MagneGrip for the purchase of vehicle exhaust removal systems for the City of Trotwood Fire Stations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROTWOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION I: The City of Trotwood solicited for bids for the purchase of vehicle exhaust removal systems for the City of Trotwood Fire Stations.

SECTION II: The Fire Chief reviewed the bids and recommends that Council accept the bid from Rossman Enterprises, Inc., dba MagneGrip.

SECTION III: The Trotwood City Council finds the bid from MagneGrip to be the lowest and best bid submitted for the vehicle exhaust removal systems for the City of Trotwood Fire Stations and, therefore, accepts the same.

The Trotwood City Council authorizes the City Manager to enter into an Agreement with MagneGrip for the purchase of vehicle exhaust removal systems for the City of Trotwood Fire Stations for the total sum of \$152,781.00, to be paid for with grant funds in the amount of \$138,891.82 from the Federal Emergency Management Agency Assistance to Firefighters Grant and the required match of 10%, or \$13,889.18, from the City of Trotwood.
