

ORDINANCE NO. OR35-22

AN ORDINANCE BY THE TROTWOOD CITY COUNCIL ESTABLISHING A NEW SPECIAL REVENUE FUND IN CONFORMITY WITH FEDERAL AND STATE LAWS AND GENERALLY ACCEPTED ACCOUNTING PRINCIPLES FOR FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE ONEOHIO DISTRIBUTOR SETTLEMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, during a Special Meeting held on August 10, 2021, the Trotwood City Council passed Resolution No. R21-35 accepting the material terms of the OneOhio Subdivision Settlement pursuant to the OneOhio Memorandum of Understanding and consistent with the terms of the July 21, 2021 National Opioid Settlement Agreement; and

WHEREAS, The OneOhio plan is a mechanism to ensure that monies from the negotiated settlement are distributed fairly to the communities hit hardest by the opioid crisis and the City of Trotwood is entitled to a portion of said funds; and

WHEREAS, the City is required to establish a separate and distinct special revenue fund to account for the OneOhio Distributor Settlement funds; and

WHEREAS, for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the City of Trotwood and in order to allow for the expedited creation of this special revenue fund, it is necessary that this Ordinance take immediate effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY A VOTE OF FIVE (5) MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROTWOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION I:

In conformity with federal and state laws and generally accepted accounting principles, the following new fund is established:

OneOhio Opioid Settlement Special Revenue Fund (#218). This special revenue fund shall be utilized to deposit revenue received from the OneOhio Distributor Settlement and to cover eligible expenditures.

SECTION II:

The Trotwood City Council declares that an emergency exists so to protect the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the City's residents and to allow for the expedited creation of this special revenue fund, which therefore requires the expedited implementation of this legislation.


SECTION IV:


In accordance with Section 4-6 of the Charter of the City of Trotwood, State of Ohio, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by Council.
