

## 2023 LEAF PICKUP PROGRAM

The Public Works Department will once again be picking up leaves from curbsides this Fall. Citizens may rake leaves into piles at the curb. **No sticks, grass clippings or other debris should be included – leaves only!** Do not bag your leaves. Any cars parked on the street should be moved, so that our crews can remove leaves safely and effectively.

**\* LEAF PILES BLOCKED BY VEHICLES WILL NOT BE PICKED UP \***

The program will begin October 16, 2023 with zone pick-ups as follows:

Zone 1:	October 16 - 17	November 6 - 7	<b>November 29</b>
Zone 2:	October 18 - 19	November 8 - 9	<b>November 30</b>
Zone 3:	October 20 & 23	November 10 & 13	<b>December 1</b>
Zone 4:	October 24 - 25	November 14 - 15	<b>December 4</b>
Zone 5:	October 26 - 27	November 16 - 17	<b>December 5</b>
Zone 6:	October 30 - 31	November 20 - 21	<b>December 6</b>
Zone 7:	November 1 - 2	November 22 & 27	<b>December 7</b>
Zone 8:	November 3	November 28	<b>December 8</b>

**NOTE:** Leaves will be picked up some time during the two-day window provided on the schedule for your zone. **Dates are estimates only and may be delayed due to weather and/or volume of leaves.** To ensure that your leaves are collected, we suggest that you have your leaves out on the curb prior to the **First** day of your zone's scheduled pick-up dates.

**Public Work crews will attempt to make a final leaf run throughout the entire City, November 29 – December 8**

At any time during the fall season, Rumpke will provide disposal of bagged leaves on your normal trash pick-up day (limit of 10 bags, per trash pick-up date). For more information regarding Rumpke's requirements, residents may call (937) 461-0004.
