## **ORDINANCE NO. OR15-24**

AN ORDINANCE BY THE TROTWOOD CITY COUNCIL REQUESTING THE STATE OF OHIO DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION MODIFY THE SPEED LIMIT TO 45 MPH ON WESTBROOK ROAD WITHIN THE CITY OF TROTWOOD, OHIO, FROM DIAMOND MILL ROAD EAST TO SALEM AVENUE (STATE ROUTE 49), AND FURTHER, TO MODIFY THE SPEED LIMIT TO 35 MPH ON WESTBROOK ROAD WITHIN THE CITY OF TROTWOOD, OHIO, FROM SALEM AVENUE (STATE ROUTE 49) EAST TO MAIN STREET (STATE ROUTE 48).

WHEREAS, residents and citizens have voiced concerns as to the posted speed limit on Westbrook Road within the City of Trotwood, Ohio, from Diamond Mill Road east to Salem Avenue (State Route 49), approximately 17952' (3.4 miles) in length; and on Westbrook Road from Salem Avenue (State Route 49) east to Main Street (State Route 48), approximately 14282' (2.71 miles) in length; and

WHEREAS, the City of Clayton, Ohio, whose jurisdiction includes the westbound lanes of the above-referenced portions of Westbrook Road, contracted Choice One Engineering (the "Contractor") to conduct a speed study, from which they recommended the speed limit be modified to 45 MPH on Westbrook Road from Diamond Mill Road to Salem Avenue (State Route 49), and further, to modify the speed limit to 35 MPH on Westbrook Road from Salem Avenue (State Route 49) to Main Street (State Route 48); and

WHEREAS, on July 18, 2024, the Clayton City Council approved a resolution requesting the State of Ohio Director of Transportation modify the speed limit on the westbound lanes of the above-referenced portions of Westbrook Road within the City of Clayton, Ohio, as recommended by the Contractor, and, is requesting the Trotwood City Council approve the same modifications to the speed limit for the eastbound lanes on the above-referenced portions of Westbrook Road; and

WHEREAS, the Trotwood City Council has determined the general welfare and safety of the traveling public requires the speed limit on the above-referenced portions of Westbrook Road within the City of Trotwood should be modified as recommended by the Contractor.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TROTWOOD, STATE OF OHIO:

The State of Ohio Director of Transportation is hereby **SECTION I**:

requested to modify the speed limit within the City of Trotwood, Ohio, to 45 MPH on Westbrook Road from Diamond Mill Road east to Salem Avenue (State Route 49), approximately 3.4 miles in length; and to 35 MPH on Westbrook Road from Salem Avenue (State Route 49) east to Main Street (State Route 48), approximately

2.71 miles in length.

The City of Trotwood, Ohio, hereby agrees, in the event **SECTION II:** 

> the speed limit is changed along the above-mentioned portions of Westbrook Road as requested, to erect and

maintain appropriate signs and markings.

This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time **SECTION III:** 

allowed by law.
